



HOW TO USE VOICEYE

Introduction

Voiceye is a free smart phone app that allows you to convert a printed VoicEye enabled document to multiple accessible formats. By scanning the unique VoicEye 2D barcode, you can access text using magnification large print, high-contrast large print, text to speech, or voice over, and can even send the text to a connected refreshable braille display. Setting up and using Voiceye on your IOS or Android device is easy, just follow these instructions:

Installing the Voiceye App


Search for “Voiceye” in the Apple App Store or in Google Play.

Select “Install” to install the application. It will not take long, and once the installation is complete, Voiceye will be displayed with other apps, and will be ready to use.

Scanning a VoicEye Barcode

To scan a VoicEye barcode, simply open the application and follow these steps.

1. Press the button on the top that says “Scan”
2. Position your phone so that the entire barcode is displayed on the phone's screen
3. A successful scan will quickly display the text stored within the barcode
4. If the code is not scanning, try adjusting the distance between your phone and the VoicEye barcode, or review our “Helpful Hints”



Using Voiceye Options

Once you have successfully scanned the barcode, you can use the following capabilities on your phone.

IOS	Android
To hear the text, turn on Voiceover. Using two fingers, swipe down from top to bottom.	To hear the text, press your phone's “Option” button, and select “Start TTS”.
To increase the font size, press the “+” button, and to decrease, press the “-“ button.	To increase the font size, under the “Setting” selection press the “+” button, and to decrease, press the “-“ button.
For high contrast modes, press the button with the four colored squares.	For high contrast modes, under the “Setting” selection press the button with four colored squares.
To access the language translator, move to the next bar by pressing the button with three dots. Select the first box with the letter “A”. To translate into another language, select the language button to the right, choose your desired language, press “Done”, and hit “Translate” on the bottom of the display.	To access the language translator, press your phone's “Option” button, and select “Translate”. To translate into another language, select the language button to the right, choose your desired language, press done, and hit “Translate” on the bottom of the display.

Helpful Hints

- A printed document with a VoicEye barcode needs to be of good quality, with a resolution of at least 600 dpi in order for the barcode to be clear and crisp enough to be scanned.
- If you are scanning from a computer monitor, ensure that there is minimal glare or reflection.
- Keep in mind that although a VoicEye barcode contains significantly more information than a QR code, multiple page documents will generally have a barcode per page.
